Sora/Overdrive App is LIVE!

We are happy to share that Berryessa Union School District students NOW can have access to 3 different libraries of books. This means there are A LOT of books to read!! Students have access to Berryessa Union School District, San Jose Public Library, and Santa Clara County Library. **No library card is required.** This is linked to all students' Clever accounts.

What is Sora by Overdrive?

It's the kid-friendly e-reader app with access to books through our local public libraries.



How to access it?

Students will login to Clever and click on the Sora by Overdrive

app. The first time you login, it will ask which library to connect you to. Choose 'Berryessa Union School District.' Once you are logged in you can add additional libraries that our students' accounts are connected to. They are 'San Jose Public Library' and 'Santa Clara County Library.'

How to check out a book?

Once you have found a book you are interested in, click on it and if it's available you will see a BORROW button under the book. If it's currently not available it will say 'Place a hold' and there is an estimation of when you will be able to borrow it.
