INDEPENDENT STUDY

The State of California expects that each school age student will be in school on school days. If you must take your child 🔊 out of school for a span of 5-10 days, you may request an Mapendent

study. Independent study is a contract with the school to complete all of the missed work while the student is away from school. It's the parent's responsibility to make sure all work is completed to grade level expectations. All independent study requests must be made at least 2 weeks in advance of the absences. The contract is signed by the parent, student, teacher and the Principal. The Principal will review the contract and decide if approval is going to be given based on these factors: attendance patterns, academic achievement, behavior and previous independent study requests. However, in order for us to educate your child best, we strongly believe that students need to be in class and highly discourage you from being out of school for an extended amount of time. There are many prescheduled vacation times during the school year when you trips can be taken.

COVID-19 TESTING FOR STUDENTS & STAFF- REGISTRATION REQUIRED

BUSD is pleased to share that we have received a grant from CDPH to offer FREE weekly on-site COVID-19 testing for our staff and students. Through this grant opportunity, we have been partnered with Primary Health as our local testing provider. A team of clinicians will be assigned to provide rapid antigen at Cherrywood School every Friday from 8:30am-4:00pm. To sign up, click HERE to register. You only need to register once.
