

WEEKLY COVID-19 TESTING FOR STUDENTS & STAFF-REGISTRATION REQUIRED

BUSD is pleased to share that we have received a grant from CDPH to offer FREE weekly on-site COVID-19 testing for our staff and students. Through this grant opportunity, we have been partnered with Primary Health as our local testing provider. A team of clinicians will be assigned to provide rapid antigen at Cherrywood School every Friday from 8:30am-4:00pm. To sign up, click HERE to register. You only need to register once. WALK N' ROLL AT CHERRYWOOD

EVERY Wednesday, we will be reinstating Wednesdays for our school starting the first week of February. This program is sponsored by the city of San Jose's

Transportation Department who we have partnered with for years. The goal is to increase traffic safety around our school during dismissal and arrival. We need parents to help with our "walking school buses." These parents would help supervise children walking to Cherrywood when they meet up with a "walking bus." In the past we have had walking school buses from the Sierrabrook Apartments and Cataldi Park.

Also, if you live farther away from school, we ask that you try to Walk a Block daily which means you park about a block away from school and walk in. There are Walk N'Roll student raffle winners weekly who win Walk N' Roll swag like stress balls, folders, maze pens, pedometers, and more for walking to school!

Finally, parent volunteers will be coordinating a drive through drop off area for students on Greengate Drive where the loading zone is currently. More information will be sent out in the next couple of weeks. Ultimately, it takes our entire school community to keep everyone safe during
