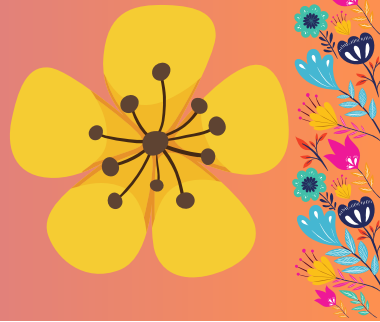

Once you activate your account, it is good for the duration that your child is in BUSD. Our Office will be closed this summer so you need to make sure you get your access code before the Office closes in June.
