Please pick up any unused medication(s) that your child has in the school office by the end of the last day of school, 6/9. If your child will continue to need any medication(s) during the school day during the next school year, including any over-thecounter medications such as Tylenol, Benadryl, and/or Advil, a Berryessa medication authorization form must be completed and signed by both the health care provider and the parent/guardian. Medication forms are available in the school office. (Forms must be signed by a doctor after July 30th for the 2023-24 school year.) **NOTE: A separate Medication Authorization Form is required for each medication each school year.
